Course Description:

A beginning piano/keyboarding musicianship course designed to provide a student with introductory skills including scales, chords, simple compositions and transpositions.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end the course the student will:

1. Identify musical symbols utilized most frequently
2. Sight-read both simple rhythms and melodies
3. Play most major and minor scales and arpeggios
4. Identify and write intervals and root position chords
5. Understand the structure of Western Tonality and the Major/Minor system
6. Be willing (and relatively comfortable) to use keyboard skills in public performance.
