

Learning Outcomes MUS 114 Piano Class I 2 credits

Course Description:

A beginning piano/keyboarding musicianship course designed to provide a student with introductory skills including scales, chords, simple compositions and transpositions.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end the course the student will:

- 1. Identify musical symbols utilized most frequently
- 2. Sight-read both simple rhythms and melodies
- 3. Play most major and minor scales and arpeggios
- 4. Identify and write intervals and root position chords
- 5. Understand the structure of Western Tonality and the Major/Minor system
- 6. Be willing (and relatively comfortable) to use keyboard skills in public performance.
